**AUTHORISATIONS UNDER THE *CORPORATIONS (ABORIGINAL AND
TORRES STRAIT ISLANDER) ACT 2006***

TAKE NOTICE that:

1. Under Section 453-1 of the *Corporations (Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander) Act 2006* (the Act) I have caused authorised officers to examine the books of the Bawinanga Aboriginal Corporation (ICN 29) and report on the results of that examination to me.
2. Under Section 447-1 of the Act I have authorised Mr Mark O'Shea and Mr Jim Sheehan from the Queensland firm of Enmark Pty Ltd to undertake the examination.

The authorised officers are entitled, at all reasonable times, to full and free access to the books of the Corporation and any related body corporate. They may also make copies of, or take extracts from, any document related to the examination.

The authorised officers are also entitled to seek explanations on any matter about the compilation of any of the Corporation's books, or to which any of the books relate.
