AUTHORISATIONS UNDER CORPORATIONS (ABORIGINAL AND TORRES STRAIT ISLANDER) ACT 2006

TAKE NOTICE that:

- Under section 453-1 of the Corporations (Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander) Act 2006 (the CATSI Act), I have caused authorised officers to examine the books of the Durri Aboriginal Corporation Medical Service (ICN: 27) and report on the results of that examination to me.
- Under section 447-1 of the CATSI Act I have authorised Mr Peter Saunders,
 Ms Ann Daniels and Mark Thompson from the New South Wales based firm of Kennedy Saunders Chartered Accountants to undertake the examination.

The authorised officers are entitled, at all reasonable times, to full and free access to the books of the corporation and any related body corporate. They may also make copies of, or take extracts from, any document related to the examination.

The authorised officers are also entitled to seek explanations on any matter about the compilation of any of the corporation's books, or to which any of the books relate.
